Income Ceiling Hiked

THROOP — Senior citizens in Throop will be able to earn up to \$4,500 and still be eligible to receive a 50 per cent reduction in their town property tax.

This was agreed to Wednesday night by town officials. ...

Although the maximum allowable exemption under state law is \$6,500, according to Town attorney James Cuddy, Cayuga County governing bodies are granting no more than \$4,500.

Town assessor Edward Metroka told board members and about 20 town residents in attendance that between 15 and 20 seniors over the age of 65 can qualify for the 50 per cent reduction in town property tax.

Renovation Of Softball Field Set

AUBURN — Renovation of the Jack Clifford Field should begin in late April or early May, according to Louis Chandler of Beardsley & Beardsley architect's.

Chandler told the city Planning Board in a meeting Wednesday night that working drawings of the site plan should be completed by the end of March. He displayed preliminary site plans of the field, located on Swift and Mary streets.

Chandler said the architectural firm's primary concern with the project at this point is the renovation of the softball field. He said players in the past have "had to play their games in a saucer of water" because of faulty drainage.
