
The band's Toronto management and label office has inexplicably been declining to say whether the album even exists but Rush's U.S. label has confirmed that Lee will release the untitled project Oct. 24, with a single to be issued Oct. 6.

Cameron plays on 10 of the 11 songs with Our Lady Peace drummer Jeremy McTaggart doing the honours on the remaining number. Mink is on guitars and Lee on bass.
